UNIDIRECTIONAL ROTATING BEZEL

The rotating bezel is a key functionality in diver watches. Its 60-minute graduations allow a diver to accurately and safely monitor diving time and decompression stops.



DOUBLE LAYER DIAL

The double layer dial has the purpose of increasing the visibility under water or dark areas.



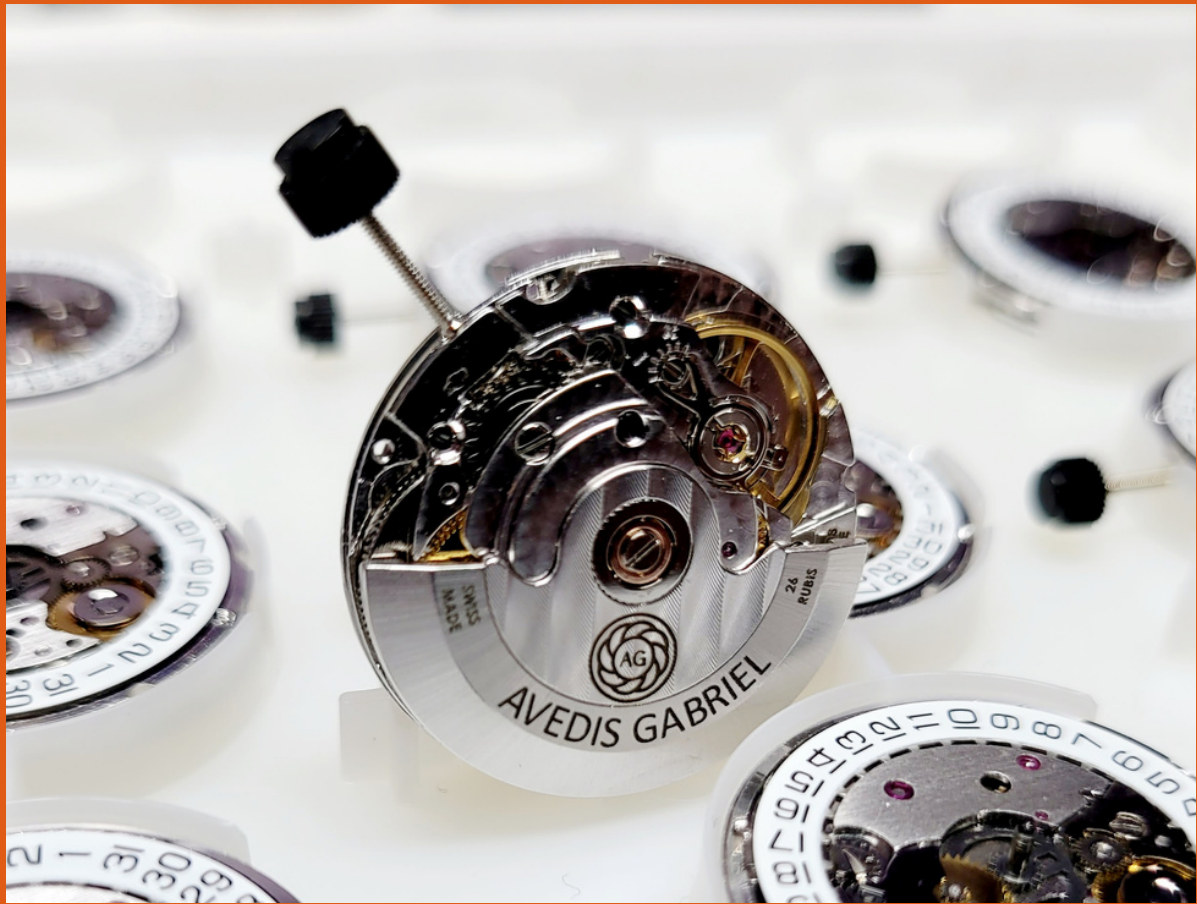
STAINLESS STEEL

Comfortable and sport chic design, the lightweight case is made out of 54g of stainless steel.



FLUORINE RUBBER BAND

The tropical fluorine rubber band (for both colors), is waterproof and breathable. the design is also inspired from the first divers watches using rubber band.



CALIBER STP 1-11

Swiss made automatic winding movement with a diameter of 25,60mm, the caliber STP 1-11 offers a power reserve of 44 hours. 26 jewels and a 28,800 vibrations per hours (4 Hz), it features hours, minutes, sweep seconds, date, and a date rapid corrector.

WEARING THE WATCH FOR THE FIRST TIME

Before being worn for the first time, or if it has stopped, the watch must be wound manually in order to function correctly and precisely.

To wind the watch manually, unscrew the winding crown completely, then turn it several times clockwise. (Turning in the other direction has no effect.) A minimum of 25 turns is required for adequate partial winding. The watch will then be wound automatically as long as it is worn on the wrist.

Carefully screw the crown back down against the case to ensure waterproofness.

SETTING THE ROYAL DIVER

To set the time, unscrew the crown and pull it out completely (2nd notch). The seconds hand is stopped, allowing you to set the time to the precise second. To set the hour and minute, turn the crown in the anticlockwise direction.

It's important to make sure, when adjusting the time, that you are in the day or night (close to the date passage). It's strongly recommended to pass the date first, by rotating the hands, then adjust properly the time.

SETTING THE ROYAL DIVER

To set the date (once the time is adjusted), push back the crown 1 notch back (second is ticking back), then rotate the crown clockwise to quick set the date.

However: it is very important to never adjust the date between 9pm and 3am. As the date gears are rotating, the finger that pushes the date disc will brake if the rapid correction is made between this time range.

Once the adjustments done, push back the crown. Then carefully screw the crown back down against the case to ensure waterproofness.

USE OF THE UNIDIRECTIONAL ROTATING BEZEL

TO CHECK THE ELAPSED TIME

Before the dive

Align the zero mark “ ▼ ” of the rotating bezel with the position of the minute hand.

During the dive

Read the scale of the rotating bezel, to which the minute hand points so as to figure out the elapsed time.

USE OF THE UNIDIRECTIONAL ROTATING BEZEL

TO CHECK THE REMAINING
TIME

Set the “ ▼ ” mark to the
scheduled time.

This way, you can now see the
amount of time that remains until
the scheduled point.

Note: The rotating bezel of
divers' watches conforming to
the ISO standard can only be
rotated counterclockwise in order
to reduce the risk of error.

CARING YOUR ROYAL DIVER

You can help preserve its lustre by cleaning it occasionally with a microfibre cloth. You can also wash the case and bracelet from time to time using soapy water and a soft brush. After wearing your watch in the sea, it is important to rinse it with fresh water to remove any salt and sand deposits.

Important:

Before cleaning your watch, always ensure that the crown is screwed down properly against the case to guarantee waterproofness.

WARRANTY COVERAGE

After the date of purchase, your Royal Diver is covered by a 3 year Service Guarantee. This guarantee excludes any damage or deterioration that results from an accident or from mishandling of the watch. Any intervention by a non-AvedisGabriel-authorized third party or the addition of any non-AvedisGabriel-manufactured parts or accessories will void the Service Guarantee.

AFTER SALE SERVICE

AvedisGabriel watch servicing ensures that your timepiece will continue to perform optimally and meet our brand requirements in terms of precision, reliability and waterproofness throughout its life.

To guarantee continued accuracy and water resistance, AvedisGabriel recommend you to periodically return your watch to an Official AvedisGabriel Retailer or Service Centre for professional servicing.

During a complete service, the watch is dismantled and all of its components (the case, bracelet and movement) are closely examined.

AFTER SALE SERVICE

The movement is entirely disassembled and all the parts are carefully inspected.

All worn parts replaced, then lubricated and reassembly.

Your watch undergoes a series of tests to verify its functions, waterproofness and power reserve, as well as the precision of its movement.

AFTER SALE SERVICE WARRANTY COVERAGE

After the complete service, your Royal Diver is covered by a 2 year Service Guarantee. This guarantee excludes any damage or deterioration that results from an accident or from mishandling of the watch. Any intervention by a non-AvedisGabriel-authorized third party or the addition of any non-AvedisGabriel-manufactured parts or accessories will void the Service Guarantee.



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
